Garden State Parkway Southbound

Take Exit 129 for the New Jersey Turnpike and head south. Take Turnpike to Exit 9, bear right after the tollbooths and follow the signs for "Route 18 North – New Brunswick." Stay to the left to continue on Route 18 North. Take the exit for Route 1 South. ***Follow the directions from US Route 1.**

Garden State Parkway Northbound

Take Exit 105 and follow signs for Route 18 North. After approximately 24 miles, you will pass the entrance for the New Jersey Turnpike. Continue on Route 18 North. Take the exit for Route 1 South. ***Follow the directions from US Route 1.**

Interstate 287

Take Exit 9 "River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park." Proceed East on River Road toward Highland Park. Make a right onto Route 18 South (exit after the traffic light at Landing Lane). Cross the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge. Continue on Route 18 South. Take the exit for Route 1 South. ***Follow the directions from US Route 1.**

New Jersey Turnpike

Take Exit 9, bear right after the tollbooths and follow signs for "Route 18 North – New Brunswick." Stay to the left to continue on Route 18 North. Take the exit for Route 1 South. ***Follow the directions from US Route 1.**

*US Route 1

From Route 1 North/South, take the exit for Ryders Lane towards New Brunswick. Make a right onto Labor Center Way. Make an immediate right into Parking Lot 96. The Labor Education Center will be the first building on the right.
