Task 1

Scenario 1:

Two workers recently reported contracting COVID-19 at New Jersey Employer ABC. Coworkers are very worried that they are at-risk of contracting COVID-19 and went to the health and safety committee with their concerns. The health and safety committee investigation revealed the following:

- 1. The main entrance is an open area with people coming and going all day. There are no consistent screening protocols, and the forehead thermometer reads 96 degrees for everyone.
- 2. The recent staff reduction is causing long wait lines. Throughout the day the reception area goes over posted maximum room occupancy.
- 3. A large piece of plastic is being used as a room divider with a sign *Sick People on one side*.
- 4. The ventilation system is not working properly, so there are portable fans to circulate the air.
- 5. Workers are using disinfectants to clean and were never trained or supplied gloves.
- 6. The employer has installed hand sanitizer dispensers, but they are usually empty.
- 7. Face coverings are required, but staff, clients and visitors do not wear them properly.
- 8. Employer XYZ has no written policy or procedures for dealing with COVID-19.

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
